Aim

The Retired Members Section of the Institution of Engineering and Technology, Surrey Local Area Network, was founded in 1989. It was set up to enable members of the Institution who have retired from their normal full-time occupations to keep in touch with former colleagues and to further the aims and traditions of the Institution by arranging regular meetings. Meetings and seminars

For our activities of a social nature the Section is financially independent of the IET Surrey Network. The cost of approved technical meetings and visits may, however, be funded by the IET.

Regular meetings, which members' partners are welcome and encouraged to attend, are held on the first Wednesday of each month at East Horsley Village Hall (KT24 6QT). A balanced programme of speakers is arranged covering technical subjects and others of a more general interest.

Visits, Walks and Christmas Luncheon

Several social and technical visits are arranged each year in the south-east area. In the latter case attendance may be restricted to members.

There is a regular programme of **short walks** of 6 to 8 km in the local network area finishing with an optional pub lunch.

The **Concert Club** arranges attendance at concerts and shows

In December each year the RMS holds a well-attended **Christmas lunch**.

Sub-Groups

Members are encouraged to share their interests with others and two sub-groups of the Section operate successfully:

Portfolio Management Group - Members interested in investments and other financial matters meet every two months in private homes for discussion and to pool their knowledge. A phantom portfolio is operated and individual members take responsibility for different market sectors. There is a small additional subscription for membership of this Group to cover the cost the cost of printing and distributing the portfolio performance reports.

Personal Computer Group - This Group meets regularly on the third Wednesday of each month at Newdigate Village Hall (RH5 5DB). It is likely to be of most interest to those having a PC running under Windows 98 or later, but other hardware and operating systems are also discussed. Generally there is a presentation of some aspect of personal computing given by a Group member or, occasionally, by an outside speaker. There is also an opportunity to discuss and, hopefully, alleviate members' computer problems. An additional subscription is levied for this Group to cover equipment hire and the cost of producing the monthly newsletter.
